

## Emergency daycare on weekends and during Easter

The covid-19 situation may affect children where all parents have jobs in critical functions. This could mean, that you will need emergency care in the weekend April 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> or during the Easter holiday on April 9<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup>.

Emergency daycare in these periods will be at the school Snebjerg Skole and the daycare facility Børneuniverset right next to the school. We cannot guarantee that a known adult will be present during weekends and Easter.

If you need emergency daycare on April 4<sup>th</sup>/April 5<sup>th</sup> or during Easter you have to sign up on this telephone number: 2924 7132

Emergency daycare on the three days leading up to Easter, April 6<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> will be like other weekdays and require prior sign up through your normal school or institution.

Please note that we, as instructed by health authorities, don't accept children who are sick at any time, regardless of symptoms.

### Help with difficult questions

We are aware that the extraordinary situation may create new dilemmas and challenges to daily life in families.

Herning Municipality offers free and anonymous Open Counselling on the phone. This is of course also an offer if you during the covid-19 situation encounter new challenges that you have not previously experienced.

In example:

- How do I provide predictability and structure for my children in a time that is so different?
- How do I talk with my child about worries about catching covid-19?
- Is it OK to let my child watch news report about covid-19?
- How do we plan our work from home to balance work life and family time?
- I work from home and feel inadequate as both a parent and an employee. What do I do?
- My child can't go to her mother's place because of covid-19. How do we maintain visitation during this situation?
